BE IT ENACTED by the City Commission of the City of Lake Wales, Polk County, Florida,

- **SECTION 1.** Chapter 2, Administration, Section 2-9 Citizen participation, subsection (d) Remarks to be relevant., is hereby amended by substitution of the text shown below:
 - (d) Remarks to be relevant. The City Commission solicits and welcomes comments from members of the public entitled to speak when the comments address subject matter that is within the Commission's scope of authority and may be of assistance in carrying out the Commission's responsibilities for the benefit of the City and its citizens, taxpayers or those services from the City concerning those services.
 Remarks from citizens shall be relevant to the agenda item underconsideration. The presiding officer shall rule of the relevancy of citizen remarks. Citizens making personal, impertinent, intimidating or threatening remarks shall be barred from further comment during the meeting.
- **SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the City Commission.
