#### **ORDINANCE 2008-37**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE WALES, POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, LAKE WALES CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ELIMINATING THE POSITION OF DEPOT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED, By the City Commission of the City of Lake Wales, Polk County, Florida:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2, ADMINISTRATION, Lake Wales Code of Ordinances, is amended as follows:

## ARTICLE II. BOARDS, COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS.

# **DIVISION 5. DEPOT ADVISORY COMMISSION**

#### SEC. 2-86. Created.

There is hereby created a depot advisory commission which shall consist of ten (10) members, of which six (6) must reside in the city limits of Lake Wales. The advisory commission members shall be appointed by the city commission for three (3) year periods. In the event of the resignation or death of a member of the depot advisory commission, the city commission shall fill such vacancy by appointment for the unexpired term. The depot executive director may be an exofficio member of the depot advisory commission, but shall not be a voting member.

### Sec. 2-87. Duties.

The depot advisory commission shall:

- (1) Advise the depot executive director <u>City Commission</u> as to the long-range planning and coordination of the Lake Wales Depot Museum and Cultural Center.
- (2) Elect a chairman from among its ranks to preside at the meetings.

#### Sec. 2-88. Executive director.

There is hereby created the position of depot executive director. The depot executive director shall be appointed by the city manager and shall perform his or her duties under the supervision of the city manager. The depot executive director shall have the following duties:

- (1) Coordinate and direct legal acquisition of any historical properties to be acquired by the city;
- (2) Supervise, coordinate and direct the maintenance, scheduling and use of the Lake Wales Depot Museum and Cultural Center;
- (3) Serve as the city's liaison to any organizations desiring to use the Lake Wales Depot Museum and Cultural Center;
- (4) Supervise and direct the activities of any city employees assigned by the city manager to the Lake Wales Depot Museum and Cultural Center.

**SECTION 2.** If any clause, section or provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason or cause, the remaining portion of said ordinance shall be in full force and effect and be valid as if such invalid portion thereof had not been incorporated herein.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the City Commission.
