

ORDINANCE 2008-41

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE WALES, POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, LAKE WALES CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING ORDINANCE 2008-37 TO ALLOW THE PRESIDENT OF THE HISTORIC LAKE WALES SOCIETY TO BE A NON-VOTING EX OFFICIO MEMBER OF THE DEPOT ADVISORY COMMISSION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED, By the City Commission of the City of Lake Wales, Polk County, Florida:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2, ADMINISTRATION, Lake Wales Code of Ordinances, is amended as follows:

ARTICLE II. BOARDS, COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS.

DIVISION 5. DEPOT ADVISORY COMMISSION

SEC. 2-86. Created.

There is hereby created a depot advisory commission which shall consist of ten (10) members, of which six (6) must reside in the city limits of Lake Wales. The advisory commission members shall be appointed by the city commission for three (3) year periods. In the event of the resignation or death of a member of the depot advisory commission, the city commission shall fill such vacancy by appointment for the unexpired term. The president of the Historic Lake Wales Society may be an ex officio member of the Depot Advisory Commission, but shall not be a voting member.

Sec. 2-87. Duties.


The depot advisory commission shall:

- (1) Advise the City Commission as to the long-range planning and coordination of the Lake Wales Depot Museum and Cultural Center.
- (2) Elect a chairman from among its ranks to preside at the meetings.


SECTION 2. If any clause, section or provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason or cause, the remaining portion of said ordinance shall be in full force and effect and be valid as if such invalid portion thereof had not been incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the City Commission.
