- 9. Ordinance 2012-02, Shooting Ranges, Indoors 1st Reading & Public Hearing
  Ordinance 2012-02 provides for indoor shooting ranges in the I-1, I-2, LCI, BP and C-3 zoning districts.
- 10. Ordinance 2012-03 Development Impact Fee Study and Schedule 1st Reading & Public Hearing
  Impact fees must be updated periodically to reflect the most current and local data used as a basis for the fees. The

"Development Impact Fee" study completed by Clarion Associates in December recommends significant reductions in most impact fees. Passage of the ordinance will adopt the impact fee study including the fee changes. Recommended reductions in fees will be effective immediately. Recommended increases in some fees will be effective April 9, following notification requirements of state law. Impact fees are charged by the city to cover the capital costs of providing water, wastewater, fire/emergency, police, library, and parks services to new development.

11. Adoption of Resolution 2012-02 C Street Project Facilities Plan

Staff is requesting that the City Commission adopt Resolution 2012-02 C Street Project Facilities Plan.
