

12. **Resolution 2012-16 – Adopting the “Polk County Complete Street Policy”**
Resolution 2012-16 provides for the adoption of the “Polk County Complete Street Policy.” This policy is a product of the Polk Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) and its member communities. The intent is to create and maintain a multi-modal transportation system, establish pedestrian connections between development and green spaces, and provide a healthy and safe environment throughout Polk County.
13. **Resolution 2012-17, Resolution 2012-17, Authorizing Eminent Domain Proceedings to acquire certain interests in real property in the C Street Lift Station 16 area**
The City Commission is asked to consider approval of a resolution for property acquisition associated with the need for the replacement of sewer lines and a lift station (i.e. “L.S. 16”) serving that area of the City in the general vicinity of “C” Street, South of Florida Avenue, West of the Seaboard Coast Line Railway Line, North of the East-West spur of the Seaboard Coast Line Railway Line and East of “G” Street (the “C” Street – L.S. 16 Area). In approving the resolution, there are five factors that must be considered. The five factors are enumerated below.
14. **Appointments – Historic District Regulatory Board and Parks & Community Appearance Advisory Board**
The appointments will fill vacancies due to resignations, expiration of terms, newly established boards, etc.
15. **Webber Marketing Study on Parks and Recreation Facilities in Lake Wales**
This is a proposal from an MBA practicum group at Webber International University to review recreation facilities in Lake Wales and provide recommendations on improved marketability and usage.
