One member shall be a resident of the unincorporated Greater Lake Wales area having a Lake Wales address or a resident of the City of Lake Wales if the Lake Wales Public Library is a member of the Polk County Cooperative and receives operating funds from Polk County Board of County Commissioners (Ordinance 2008-07; 02/19/08). (5-year term)

- Members are not required to file an annual Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests

The Lake Wales Library Association – Friends of the Library has supported the Lake Wales Public Library since 1957. That year a group of dedicated citizens began raising funds for a new library. Their hard work came to fruition when the doors of the Lake Wales Public Library were opened in 1960 on the shores of Crystal Lake. Through the generosity of the citizens of Lake Wales the first red-brick library was built with 100% donations.

In 1991 this library was quadrupled in size, again through the fundraising efforts of the Lake Wales Library Association – Friends of the Library. This \$165,000 expansion and renovation was funded completely with donations.

In 2013 the Lake Wales Library Association – Friends of the Library collected \$85,000 in donations and renovated the 20+ year old interior of the library. With the help of Capital Improvement funds from the City of Lake Wales new carpeting and flooring was laid and our library was given a clean, beautiful new face.

The Lake Wales Library Association – Friends of the Library is committed to supporting the Lake Wales Public Library's efforts to be a great community resource. They underwrite the cost of children's programs, adult programs, new library materials and electronic resources. They annually sponsor the cost of a Lake Wales 4th grade's field trip to the *Cracker Storytelling Festival*. The Lake Wales Library Association – Friends of the Library donates annually to the United Way of Central Florida's Success by Six program. Their donation provides funds for a Lake Wales child to receive a new book each month from the Dolly Parton Imagination Library beginning at birth thru age five. This extraordinarily supportive group of library lovers has made our public library a better place.




